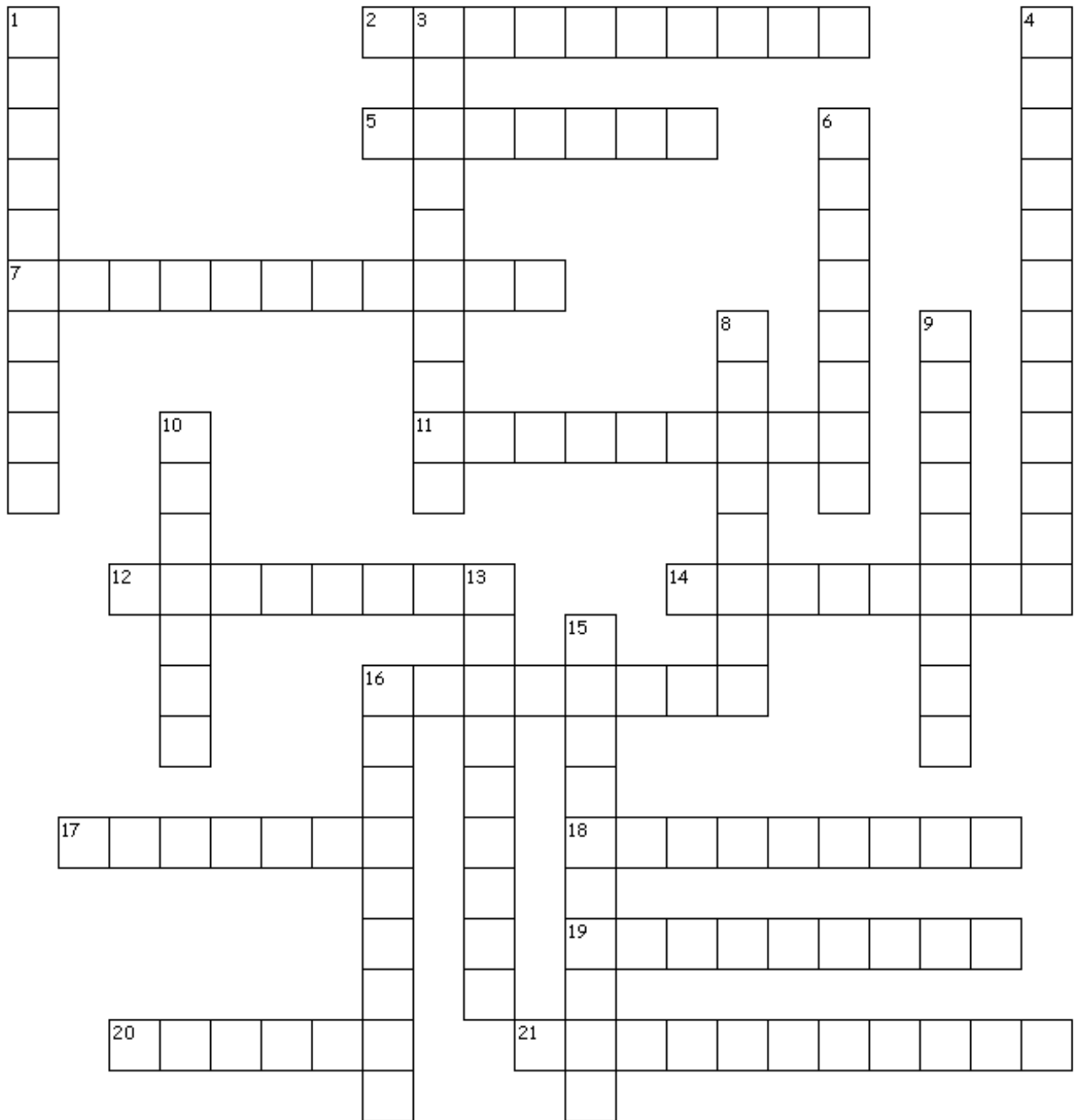


Spelling Lesson 21: Words with Double Consonants
