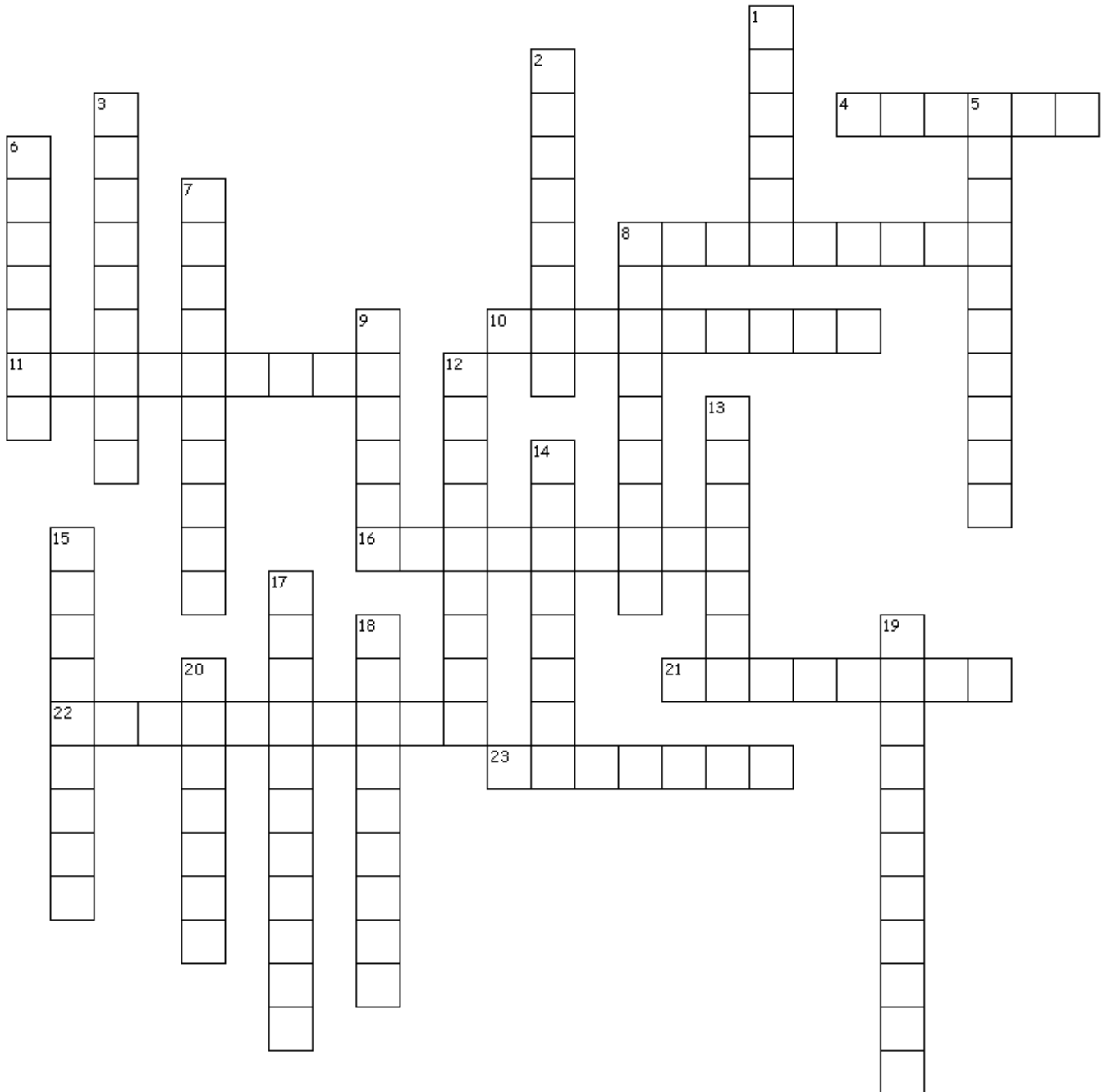


### Spelling Lesson 31: More Latin Roots
