Language Arts — 8th-Grade Writing Assignment Persuasive Composition (Letter) Compare and Contrast

- Objective: Students will be able to write and type a well-organized, logical, persuasive composition with a clear thesis or proposition using a standard, non-business letter format. (Standards W2.3, W2.4)
- Prompt 1: A third-grade student wants a pet. If the choice is between a *kitten* and a *puppy*, which would you recommend?
- Prompt 2: As a homeroom representative in the Columbia Student Congress, which spirit day would you recommend, <u>Black and White Day</u> or <u>Hawaiian Day</u>?
- Prompt 3: Your basketball coach has offered to buy drinks for the team. Which would you recommend, *Monster*, and energy drink, or *Propel*, a sports drink?
- Prompt 4: It's time for high school registration. Which elective would you recommend, <u>Spanish</u> or <u>French</u>?
- Prompt 5: Colleges will be asking for a list of your high school activities; your friend, however, is not sure which activity will be more impressive, being on the <u>school newspaper</u> or the <u>varsity</u> <u>basketball team</u>. What would you recommend to him or her?
- Prompt 6: As a reward for outstanding work at school, your best friend's rich uncle is going to buy him or her a surprise gift, but the uncle needs your advice. Which should he buy, a <u>PSP</u> hand-held game system or a new <u>phone/MP3/video player</u>?
- Assignment: You will write a persuasive letter in which you attempt to convince someone (your audience) to take a particular action (buy or do something). Feel free to change the underlined, italicized words however, substitutes must make sense, must be appropriate, and must be approved by the teacher. The letter is to be organized using compare and contrast; that is, you will explore two possible choices. This means that your letter needs to do the following:
 - Provide information on how the two choices are alike and different.
 - Make a clear recommendation based on the evidence stating which is the better choice and why. In other words, after you have done your analysis, you MUST CHOOSE ONE AND ONLY ONE ALTERNATIVE.
 - Make sure you use specific details, examples, and good, logical reasons to support your claims. This assignment is due on _______.
