## Language Arts — 8th-Grade Writing Assignment Response to Literature

Objective: Students will be able to write an effective response to literature that includes a thesis and

evidence drawn from the selection(s). (Standards W2.2, W2.3, W2.4)

Prompt 1: The setting of *The Diary of Anne Frank* is the top floor of a warehouse in Amsterdam,

Holland, during World War II. Two families and one other individual, all Jews, try to live in these cramped quarters under difficult circumstances while hiding from the Germans because they do not want to be taken to concentration camps. Explore the relationship between the setting, the way the characters deal with their circumstances, and one of the

story's important themes.

Prompt 2: Choose a narrative poem or short story from the list below. Explore the relationship

between the selection's setting, literary devices, and mood.

The Highwayman (Noyes) The Cremation of Sam McGee (Service)

Paul Revere's Ride (Longfellow) The Tell-Tale Heart (Poe)
The Raven (Poe) The War Prayer (Twain)

Prompt 3: Flowers for Algernon centers on a man, Charlie Gordon, and how he struggles to become

an intelligent, enlightened human being. Analyze Charlie's character, including his reactions to his changing circumstances, and explore how his struggles may or may not be

a metaphor for life in general, and what the implications might be for us.

Assignment: Write to only one specific prompt; you must also formulate your own properly-constructed

thesis and support your thesis with evidence, such as specific details, quotes from the selection, examples, explanations, observation, and sound, logical reasons. This
